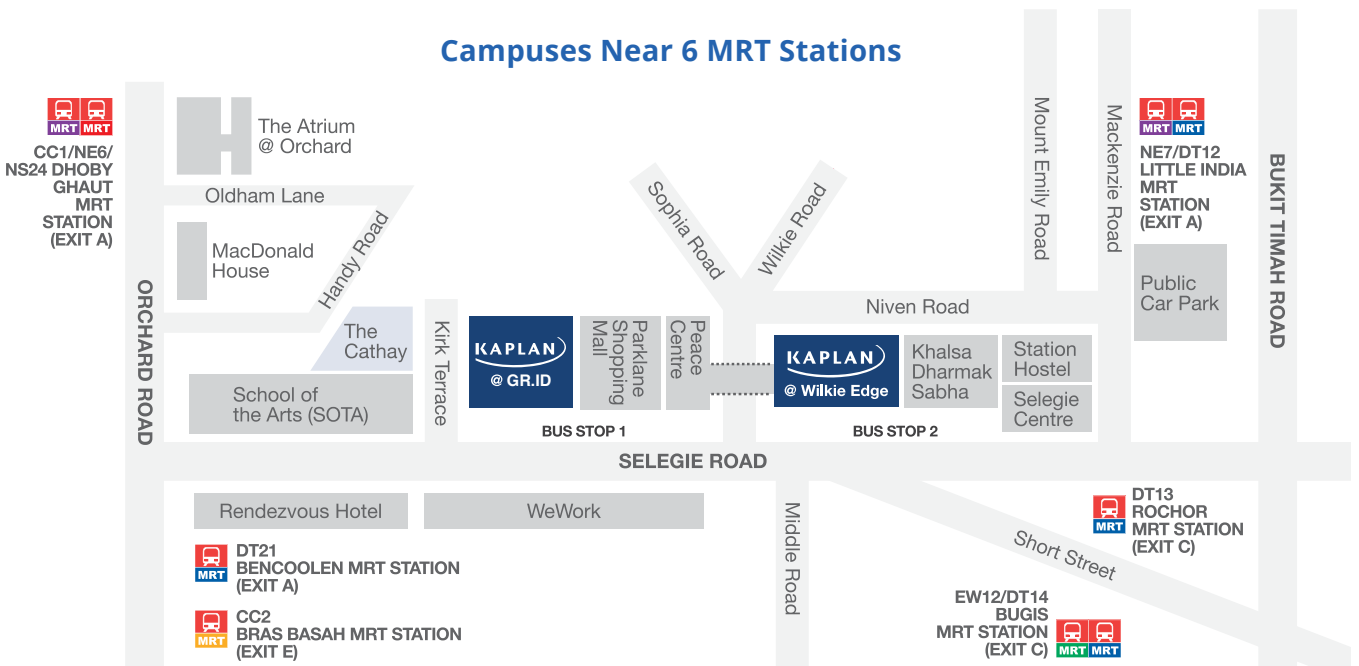

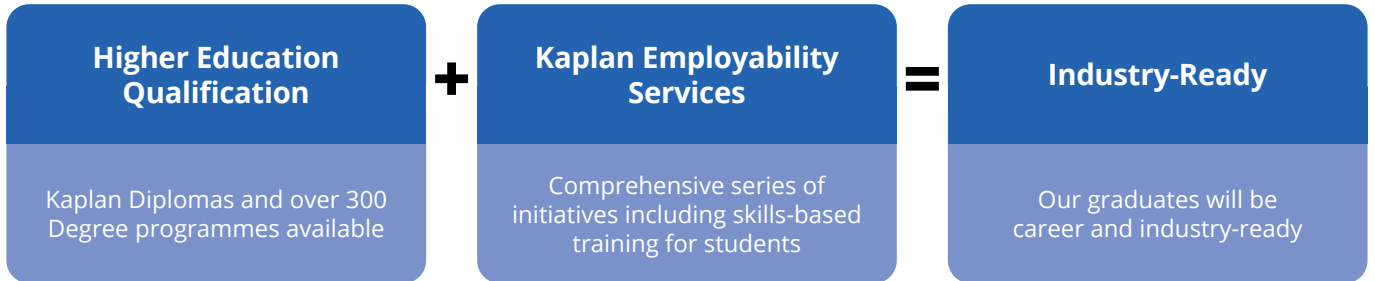
Campuses Near 6 MRT Stations
